Show Regulations:

1. JURISDICTION

The show will be held under licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. As in force on 27th June 2026. All dogs must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.

2. **Venue** The show will be held at **St Patrick's GAA Club Ballyragget, Co Kilkenny** on Saturday 27th June 2026, Judging will commence at 11am. Entries will be received up to and including 17th **June 2026 postmark** by the secretary: Ms. Kate Sialitskaya , 5 Ballybrusa, Grange, Youghal, Co.Cork.
Online closes on the 20th June 2026

3. The promoting body shall have the right to refuse any entry.

4. ENTRIES

Entry Fee of €28 for first entry and €15 for each dog thereafter.

Neutered Classes €15.00 per dog

Pet Class €10.00 per dog

No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

4. JUDGING

If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her appointment, the committee reserves to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the promoting body to change a judge in a breed if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the show.

5. The promoting body shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any dog in the ring. In the event of an exhibitor requesting a Steward or other official to handle his or her exhibit in the ring, any such official may voluntarily do so but on the distinct understanding that such an action is on behalf of the owner and does not involve the promoting body in any responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage consequential or otherwise.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'dog' denotes both sexes)

A BABY PUPPY CLASS – is for dogs over four months and under six months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition.

PUPPY CLASS - is confined to dogs over six months and under twelve months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A JUNIOR CLASS - is confined to dogs over nine months and under eighteen months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A INTERMEDIATE CLASS – is confined to dogs over fifteen months and under twenty four months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

AN ADULT CLASS: is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

AN OPEN CLASS - is for dogs over fifteen months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A VETERAN CLASS - is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

CHAMPION CLASS is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Limited rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor.

Neuter Stakes: Neuter Stakes can be scheduled by Show Societies. This is optional.

Pet class: Any age pets who are not entered in any of the standard classes. For standard coloured pets only.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
