SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Rules-** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., as in force on the day of the publication of this schedule.
All Dogs must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
Venue: The Show will be held at **The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Swords, Co. Dublin** between the hours of 9.00 and 6.00 p.m. on **Saturday 23rd May 2026**.
Admission: €2.00.
2. **Entry Fees:** The Entry Fee will be €28.00 for first dog including Car Park and €10.00 for each other dog or class. Baby Puppy €5.00 per dog, Neutered Class €5.00 per dog. €5.00 per dog, for Puppy Stakes, €5.00 per dog, for Veteran Stakes. €5.00 per dog, for Champion Stakes. Entries will be received up to and including 10th May 2026 (postmark) by the Show Secretary, Mrs E. Hurley, 14 Grange Park View, Raheny, Dublin 5. (01) 8481621/ 087 2652430

3. **The Show Committee** will not accept any responsibility for mistakes in the Catalogue which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
4. **The Entry Fees** of exhibits failing to arrive or rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon will be forfeited.
5. **JUDGES:** In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her appointment, the committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
6. **Judging:** (1) The judging will commence with at 11 am. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late.(2) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.(3) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by his handler who shall not wear badge or other decoration in the judging ring. (4) Under no circumstances may the order of judging as provided for in the Catalogue be departed from.
7. **CATALOGUES** - The Promoting Body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect, occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue. In any such case the exhibitor should immediately inform the ring steward, if the judging is in progress, otherwise the exhibitor should immediately report the Catalogue inaccuracy at the Secretary's Office. Catalogues will be on sale price €3.00.
8. **ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE** - The promoting club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the Show through accident or otherwise.
9. **NOTICE** - All announcements appearing in the Dog column of the Dublin Papers (Evening Edition) prior to the date of the closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the Promoting Body in the Schedule or in these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

EXHIBITORS ARE DEEMED TO BE FULLY AQUAINTED WITH AND ARE SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE IRISH KENNEL CLUB LTD., ALL DOGS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE I. K. C.

Note I. K. C. Rule 131

Re: Registration of Dogs Entered.

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- (A) The Dog being disqualified from the event and
- (B) The exhibitor being fined €127.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I. K. C.) Office routine.

New Rule: Dogs under 6 months of age may not be shown except at Breed Club Shows only where Baby Puppy Classes are scheduled. Dogs entered in these classes may not compete for any other award.

Baby Puppies may not compete for Green Stars, but may compete for Best Baby Puppy in Show.

CLASS DEFINITIONS
(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition (**All Scheduled Breeds**)

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, .

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.******

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show,

****** Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.****

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Restricted / Special Classes (i.e. Colour Classes etc) The dog must be entered in one of the standard classes scheduled for the breed, as above.

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor
